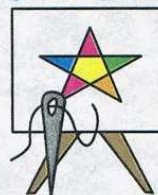

The meeting was called to order by Sandy Waters at 5:30 pm.

**Secretary's Report:** The April minutes were accepted with change. The change was that JoAnne Belling is the July presenter rather than June. The June meeting will be Melessa Collins from Frond Design.

**Treasurer's Report:** The treasurer's report was accepted and filed for audit.

**Old Business:** The Guild still needs new officers. The positions open are President Elect and Program Chair Elect.
