

Secretary's report: The minutes of the October meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's report: The treasurer's report was presented and filed for audit.

Old Business: Sue Bauer reported the Guild banner has been located. Liz Wehrmacher reviewed the new member packet. We discussed the guild policies. We will review them after the first of the year.
