WORKSHOP: PRESIDENT'S WORKSHOP

Sue Bauer will be leading the May workshop. She will demonstrate the "buzz saw" pattern which uses 2 coordinating fabrics (usually one light and one dark). We work with 8.5 squares. "I got 3.5 yards each which allowed me to use one as outside borders. But without borders you can have 3 yards each for lap robe size." Bring sewing machine, thread, rotary cutter, mat, rulers. If one has a square ruler with diagonal marking that's nice to have to square up the blocks.



Secretary's report: The minutes of the April meeting were read and approved.

Treasurer's report: The treasurer's report was presented and filed for audit.
