SCRAPS FROM THE KQ GUILD PRESIDENT

Here we go! As I look at the calendar and it says June but outside feels like it is August. It's hard to believe that summer is just beginning but the dog days of August have hit us already. Even so, this month is exciting because we can begin a more 'normal' year of KQ workshops and programs. With that in mind, I better get busy with the final decision of the President's challenge.

There is one thing we really need to work on this year and that is acquiring a full board. We are still in need members to fill the positions of newsletter editor and elect, program chair and elect and PR/historian. Please consider volunteering so board members do not have to double up on their duties. Even if you have already held an office at one time, please consider filling these positions.

Each month I will try to talk about one of my sources for quilting your quilt. I will try to give you a website, title of reference books or videos that I watch. I do not mean in any way to promote one over the other. I am just hoping to give you some resources to use and encouragement.

"Quilting your Quilt"

Most of you know that I own a long arm machine. However, I know many of you quilt your own quilts. The common ways to quilt a quilt are pantographs, free motion quilting and rulers. My passion seems to be in using rulers. I have MANY long arm rulers. You may be thinking what good does that do me if I don't have a long arm! However, there are almost as many rulers for long arm quilting as there are for domestic machines.

One of my many sources for rulers is Quilter's Rule which is a business located in Waterford, WI. They have rulers for Long-, Mid- and Short-arm machines (both stand-up and sit-down) and High Shank Home machines with appropriate ruler foot. These are $\frac{1}{4}$ inch acrylic. They also have thinner acrylic, $\frac{3}{16}$ inch acrylic for Home Machine quilting.

The great thing about this company is that they have videos to watch and PDF instructions can be printed. I have found them most helpful in learning ways to use the rulers. To find these instructions, go to their website: https://quiltersrule.com and explore. I like to click on the Instructions tab where I can watch videos or print PDF's to guide how to use these rulers. Just about every ruler I have bought from them, I have printed instructions for use.

QUILTS TO SHARE

Quilts to Share Work Days are held each Monday of the month, except the third Monday, from 9am to 3 pm. Stop in to work with others on QTS projects for all or part of the day. Sewing machines and all supplies are available. Nothing to prepare, no machine to drag around, just come. Please bring a sack lunch if you are planning to be there at noon.


