


July 18, 2022 - Presenter Heidi Kaisand, Conrad

Secretary's Report: Minutes of the June board meeting were emailed to board members and approved.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's report was presented and filed for audit.

Old Business: The following Board positions are still open for the 22-23 year: President-elect and Program Chair-elect. Before the meeting Board members looked at the stored information and eliminated any duplicate information. We reviewed the log in for the guild email account. We discussed possibly purchasing quilt display racks from the Independence Quilt Guild but are waiting to hear back from them. The Quilt Show registration will be available soon.

Membership: There were 39 members at the June meeting which included 2 new members and 3 guests. Our current membership is 70 members. Membership booklets will be available at the August meeting and dues need to be paid by July 31, 2022 to be included in the booklet.

Newsletter: The deadline for the July newsletter is Friday, July 8th.
