"Tips, tricks and Techniques from the President"

- To achieve the utmost accuracy, after squaring up fabric, turn the mat instead of the fabric to avoid shifting.
- Here's one you might want to try when sewing on binding. Wind binding around an empty toilet paper tube and hang it with a cord or ribbon around your neck. The binding will roll off the tube as you sew it onto your quilt. It stays neat and keeps you from tripping over your binding.
 - Continue to stay *Warm* and *Friendly*!





Dode Westendorf is going to help us use up some of our scraps.


Program: The Amigos, Dode, with the help of some of her friends will be doing a skit for us.
