- Use extra return address labels to identify rulers, mats, rotary cutters and other small tools you take with you on retreats and workshops. If they are left behind, the finder will know how to contact you.

#### Poinsettia Supply List

Pattern & Fabric

**12" or 18" template plastic** (or get a card from me)

Add a Quarter Ruler

**Thread** 

**Seam Ripper** 

**Rotary cutter** 

6" x 24" ruler (or similar) - smaller rulers may come in handy but are not required

**Scissors** 

Sewing machine and accessories - including quarter inch foot

**Glue stick** (Elmer's glue sticks are my favorite)

**Flower Pins** 

1 or 2 Gallon Ziploc bags - 4 or 5 for this project

Paper clips and binder clips

Optional but recommended:

Extra blades - a new blade is recommended when starting

Scotch tape (if you plan on not making a mistake, then you don't need this)

**Size 70 Microtex Needles** (sharp and long lasting for paper piecing)

Purple Thang - not required, but comes in handy!

**Glue Pens -** Avery, Fons & Porter etc. Not required, but you will want this for curved piecing!! (I will bring some along to purchase


