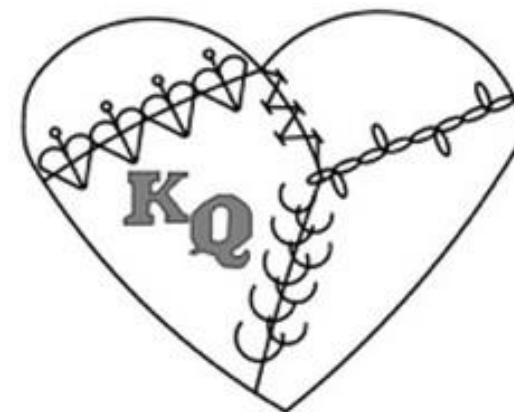

During the business portion of our meeting we invite the month's workshop participants to share what they created in the workshop. At the end of the business portion of the meeting we give members an opportunity to share their latest completed project and invite them to tell us a little about the project. Those who share their work will be awarded a small ribbon.

Ribbons are awarded as follows:

Blue = 1 per showing

Green - 1 per workshop project shared

10 green ribbons = 1 yellow ribbon

Pink = 1 per completed guild challenge project

Lime Green = 1 per quilt entered in KQ Quilt Show.
