Make sure your printer is set to 100% or "no scaling" before you print your pdf.




Ooh-Rah is finished! When you complete this final part of the series, you'll have a wonderful quilt, one you can be proud of.

Parts one through eleven of *Ooh-Rah* can be seen at www.QuiltersNewsletter.com. The complete yardage is listed in part one.

ASSEMBLY

Wash, starch and press fabrics. Cut the patches listed in the materials and cutting box and shown in the rotary cutting diagrams.

Referring to the block 12 piecing diagram, join 1 G, 4 R's, 4 dark blue #1 S's, 12 ivory S's and 4 T's to make block 12.



Don a design wall or large, flat surface, and referring to the quilt assembly diagram, arrange the blocks, sashing strips and U's as shown. When you are satisfied with the arrangement, join the blocks and patches into rows then join the rows.

Atching centers and ends, join the 61" light blue borders to the sides of the quilt. Join a Q to each end of a 46½" light blue border. Repeat. Matching centers and ends, join these borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.

■ In a similar manner, join the 64" dark blue #3 borders to the sides of the quilt. Join a C to each end of a 49½" dark blue #3 border. Repeat. Join these borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.

In the same manner, join the 70[∞] light blue borders to the sides of the


MATERIALS AND CUTTING

Cutting listed below is for part 12 only, which includes block 12 and the quilt assembly.

BLOCK SIZE: 12"	QUILT SIZE: 60 ¹ /2″ x 75″
MATERIALS	PART 12 CUTTING
Dark Blue #1	1 G, 4 S, 4 T
Light Blue	2 borders 3¼″ x 70″,
	2 borders 3¼″ x 55½″,
	2 borders 2″ x 61″,
	2 borders 2″ x 46½″
lvory	4 R, 12 S
Dark Blue #2	31 sashing strips 3″ x 12½″
Red	4 C, 4 Q, 20 U, 4 V
Dark Blue #3	2 borders 3½″ x 64″,
	2 borders 3½″ x 49½″,
	8 binding strips 2¼″ x 40″
Backing	2 horizontal panels 40″ x 65″
Batting	65″ x 79″

ROTARY CUTTING

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Align arrows with lengthwise or crosswise grain of fabric.



quilt. Join a V to each end of a $55\frac{1}{2}$ "light blue border. Repeat. Join these borders to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Ank quilting motifs as desired. Layer the backing, batting and quilt top. Baste. Quilt the marked motifs or quilt as desired. Bind the quilt to finish.
