## Ooh-Rah <br> PART 4 OF 12

## This block, the fourth in the Quilters Newsletter Block of the Month Mystery Quilt for 2014, is one that takes on a whole new look when you make an entire quilt with it.

## ASSEMBLY

1 Wash, starch and press fabrics. Cut the patches listed in the materials and cutting box and shown in the rotary cutting diagrams.

2 Referring to the unit 1 diagram, join an ivory $F$ and a dark blue \#1 F to make a unit 1 . Make 16 unit l's.

3 Referring to the block 4 piecing diagram, join 16 unit l's, 4 dark blue \#1 G's and 16 light blue G's to make block 4. Q



Block 4 was taken from issue \#6 of Quilters Newsletter (April 1970) where it was identified as The Calico Puzzle and labeled as a reprint from the Kansas City Star in 1930.

The Quilted in Honor fabric comes in many colors, shades and prints. Feel free to choose whichever you prefer.

## ROTARY CUTTING

Measurements include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances. Align arrows with lengthwise or crosswise grain of fabric.
