## Ooh-Rah <br> PART 5 OF 12

This two-color block, the fifth in the Quilters Newsletter Block of the Month Mystery Quilt for 2014, would make a lovely quilt with the same ivory background and a different color in each block, or try two different colors for the H's and I's.

## ASSEMBLY

1 Wash, starch and press fabrics. Cut the patches listed in the materials and cutting box and shown in the rotary cutting diagrams.
2 Referring to Fig. 1, lay an ivory batik G on a dark blue \#1 H as shown, right sides together. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the G and stitch on the marked line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance and press the G open. Repeat with the other 3 corners of the H to make a unit 2. Make 5 unit 2's.

3 Referring to the block 5 piecing diagram, join 5 unit 2's, 4 dark blue \#1 I's and 4 ivory l's to make block 5. Q

Cutting listed below is for block five only.
BLOCK SIZE: 12"
MATERIALS
Dark Blue \#1 QUILT SIZE: 601/2" x 75 "

Ivory block 5 CUTTING
$5 \mathrm{H}, 4 \mathrm{I}$
$20 \mathrm{G}, 4 \mathrm{I}$


Block 5 was taken from issue \#5 of Quilters Newsletter (March 1970) where it was identified as Sawtooth.

The Quilted in Honor fabric comes in many colors, shades and prints. Feel free to choose whichever you prefer.

ROTARY CUTTING
Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Align arrows with lengthwise or crosswise grain of fabric.
