## ASSEMBLY

1 Wash, starch and press fabrics. Make templates for M/Mr and $N$. Cut the patches listed in the materials and cutting box and shown in the rotary cutting diagrams.
2 Referring to the block 8 piecing diagram, join 10 dark blue \#1 G's, 10 ivory G's, 4 M's, 4 Mr's and 4 N's to make block 8 . Q

BLOCK SIZE: 12"
materials
Dark Blue \#1
Ivory QUILT SIZE: 60½" x 75 " bLock 8 CUTTING $10 \mathrm{G}, 4 \mathrm{M}, 4 \mathrm{Mr}^{*}$ $10 \mathrm{G}, 4 \mathrm{~N}$
*Mr=M reversed
ALSO NEEDED: template plastic


Block 8 was taken from issue \#4 of Quilters Newsletter (February 1970) where it was identified as a 54-40 or Fight block.
