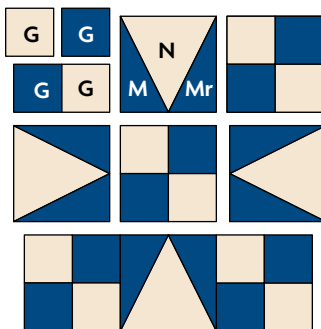
The *Quilted in Honor* fabric comes in many colors, shades and prints. Feel free to choose whichever you prefer.

Block 8 was taken from issue #4 of *Quilters Newsletter* (February 1970) where it was identified as a 54-40 or Fight block.

ASSEMBLY

1 Wash, starch and press fabrics. Make templates for M/Mr and N. Cut the patches listed in the materials and cutting box and shown in the rotary cutting diagrams.

2 Referring to the block 8 piecing diagram, join 10 dark blue #1 G's, 10 ivory G's, 4 M's, 4 Mr's and 4 N's to make block 8.

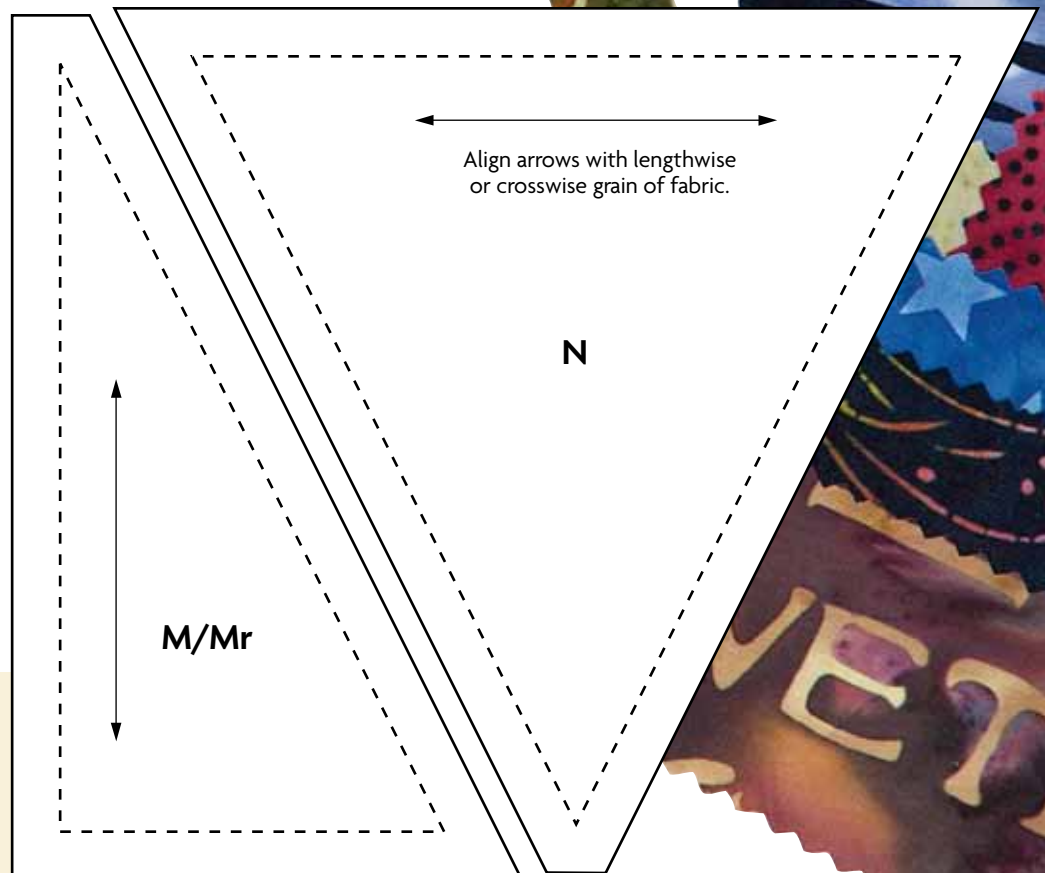
BLOCK SIZE: 12" QUILT SIZE: 60½" x 75"

MATERIALS BLOCK 8 CUTTING

Dark Blue #1 10 G, 4 M, 4 Mr*
Ivory 10 G, 4 N

*Mr=M reversed

ALSO NEEDED: template plastic



ROTARY CUTTING

Measurements include ¼" seam allowances. Align arrows with lengthwise or crosswise grain of fabric.
