PART 9 OF 12
The star points created by the templates in this block have an unusual shape. Make an entire quilt using the block and watch a beautiful secondary star pattern emerge.

ASSEMBLY
1 Wash, starch and press fabrics. Make templates for $L$ and $M / M r$. Cut the patches listed in the materials and cutting box and shown in the rotary cutting diagrams.
2 Referring to the block 9 piecing diagram, join 12 light blue F's, 8 dark blue \#1 F's, 4 ivory F's, 8 dark blue \#1 G's, 4 light blue L's, 4 ivory M's and 4 ivory Mr's to make block 9. Q
