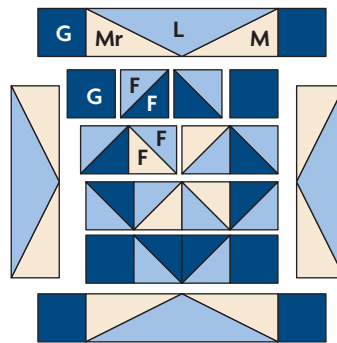


Block 9 was taken from issue #9-10 of *Quilters Newsletter* (July 1970) where it was identified as Finnigan's Wake.

ASSEMBLY

1 Wash, starch and press fabrics. Make templates for L and M/Mr. Cut the patches listed in the materials and cutting box and shown in the rotary cutting diagrams.

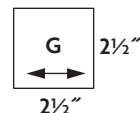
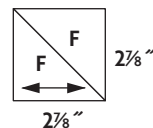
2 Referring to the block 9 piecing diagram, join 12 light blue F's, 8 dark blue #1 F's, 4 ivory F's, 8 dark blue #1 G's, 4 light blue L's, 4 ivory M's and 4 ivory Mr's to make block 9.



BLOCK 9 PIECING

ROTARY CUTTING

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Align arrows with lengthwise or crosswise grain of fabric.
